

IMPORTANT NOTICES FOR ALL PHYSICIAN LICENSE APPLICANTS

POST-GRADUATE TRAINING REQUIREMENTS

Effective January 1, 2011, all applicants for physician licensure other than a training license must demonstrate not less than one (1) of the following:

- (A) Successful completion of not less than two (2) years of postgraduate training in an A.C.G.M.E., A.O.A. or R.C.P.S.C. accredited program; **or**,
- (B) Successful completion of not less than one (1) year of postgraduate training in an A.C.G.M.E., A.O.A. or R.C.P.S.C. accredited program **and**:
 - (1) Current certification by a medical specialty board that is a member of the American Board of Medical Specialties or the Bureau of Osteopathic Specialists and Boards of Certification; **or**
 - (2) Continuous medical licensure in good standing in a combination of one or more states and/or the District of Columbia for the preceding five (5) years.

Pursuant to Board of Medicine rules, application fees received from persons not meeting these criteria **will not be refunded**. Ch. 1, § 8(a).

CREDENTIALS SERVICE REQUIRED

All physicians applying for licensure in the State of Wyoming must use the Federation Credentials Verification Service (FCVS) to submit the following documentation: Applicant's identity and legal presence in the U.S.; medical education; post-graduate training; examination history; and, if applicable, ECFMG and/or ABMS certification.
