

Renewal Process for Physician Assistants

2012 On-Line Physician Assistant License Renewal has closed.

Licensees missing the **December 31st** renewal deadline who provide to the Board, in writing and not later than sixty (60) days after the renewal deadline, a statement of good cause for failure to submit their application for renewal in a timely manner, *may* be granted an extension of not greater than thirty (30) days by the Executive Director in which to submit their application, the appropriate renewal fee (\$125), and the license renewal grace period surcharge (\$50).

A licensee whose request for an extension of the renewal application deadline is received by the Board more than sixty (60) days after the renewal deadline *may* be granted an extension for submitting their renewal application (and the required renewal fee and grace period surcharge) of not greater than thirty (30) days only with the approval of a majority of the Board officers.

Nothing herein imposes a duty on the Board of Medicine or the Executive Director to grant an extension to any licensee.

Licensees who fail to renew their license by the **December 31st** renewal deadline, and who are not granted a license renewal grace period, are required to go through the reactivation process to restore their license to active status.
